#### 1. Statement of Purpose

In a separate essay no longer than 3 pages, address how you demonstrate the values of the MMUF program and Dr. Benjamin E. Mays. Please include your name and SID # on your essay. Criteria will be weighed by the following, with particular emphasis on your academics:

- i. Academic promise
- ii. Motivation and maturity for graduate study
- iii. Intellectual potential in graduate Mellon field of study
- iv. Leadership as a mentor to African American, Chicano/Latino, and Native American students
- v. Contribution to diversity in your field of study
- vi. Background and experience living or working with African American, Chicano/Latino or Native American communities
- vii. Demonstrated commitment to the following:
  - a. Understanding the barriers faced by underrepresented minorities
  - b. Breaking down stereotypes
  - c. Increasing understanding across racial and ethnic groups

#### 2. College-level writing sample

Provide a college-level writing sample that represents your strongest work (no more than 10 pages)

3. **College/University Transcripts and copy of current semester class schedule** Submit your **official** college/university transcripts from all schools attended.

#### 4. Letters of Recommendation
